### Objectives

- Exploring reasons for boundary transgressions

Workshop content: During this one day workshop the facilitator will discuss and explore with you the "foundation" stones" of professional boundaries. Using a number of actual case scenarios participants will experience the complexities of professional boundaries whilst appreciating the ease with which transgressions occur. Through exploring the professional boundary framework you will be able to experience the continuum of over and under involvement. The zoom workshop provides a discussion and experiential space in which you can identify and practice a range of strategies to assist you develop and maintain boundaries in your professional role. We'll explore various themes which help to deepen knowledge and skills in working safely, and with care.

- Dual relationships and other complexities
- Roles we play
- · Reasons that transgressions occur.

Using a professional boundary framework the facilitator will explore boundary crossings and violations in the continuum of over- and under- involvement. Psychodrama will be used to deepen participants experiential learning, helping them gain awareness and insight and to also accelerate the rate of integration of the material.
